#### Hola — Hello

Pronunciation: OH-lah

Warm, universal, and always appreciated.

## ¿Dónde está el baño? — Where is the bathroom?

Pronunciation: DOHN-deh es-TAH el BAH-nyo

"Baño" has that ñ sound—like canyon. Practice it!

### La cuenta, por favor. — The bill, please.

Pronunciation: lah CWEN-tah por fah-VOR

Use this after your café con leche or paella.

#### Quisiera... — I'd like...

Pronunciation: kee-SYEH-rah

Use at restaurants or shops: "Quisiera una cerveza, por favor."

### ¿Cuánto cuesta? — How much does it cost?

Pronunciation: CWAN-toh CWES-tah

Perfect for markets and souvenir shops.

# No hablo mucho español. — I don't speak much Spanish.

Pronunciation: noh AH-bloh MOO-cho es-pah-NYOL

Honest and humble—opens friendly doors.

### ¿Habla inglés? — Do you speak English?

Pronunciation: AH-blah een-GLES

Use if you're stuck—but always start with a 'Hola'!

### Me gusta esto. — I like this.

Pronunciation: meh GOOS-tah ES-toh

Use when complimenting food, art, music, or souvenirs.

### ¡Salud! — Cheers!

Pronunciation: sah-LOOD

Raise a glass at your Spanish & Sip night ■

### Gracias / De nada — Thank you / You're welcome

Pronunciation: GRAH-syahs / deh NAH-dah

Essential phrases to show kindness & respect.
